By joining our Network, you will have a chance to make a real difference in protecting and improving the environment while being part of a welcoming team of people who will support your company's sustainability goals.

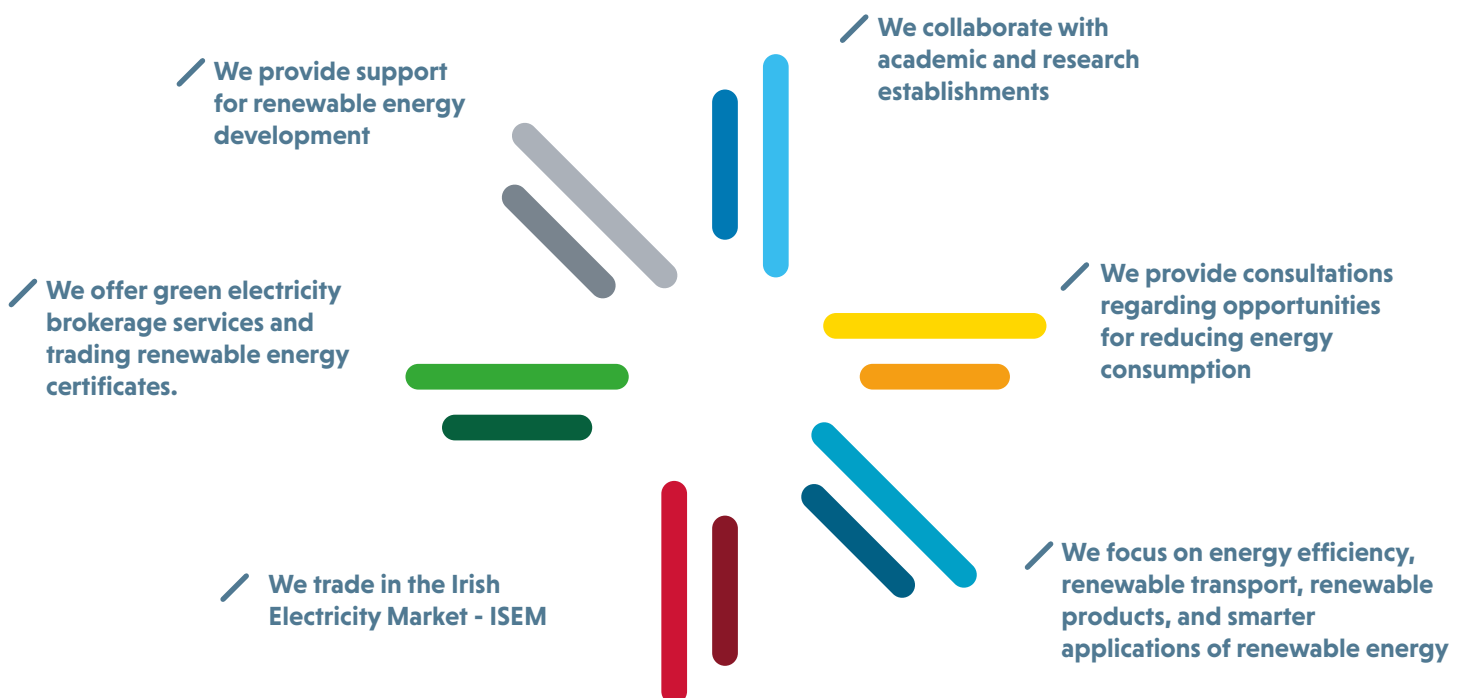

Our activities are principally financed from the trading functions of our subsidiaries, particularly Action Renewables Energy Trading (ARET) Ltd.
